GENERAL INFORMATION

Horizon is a low-foam, general purpose, nonionic/anionic adjuvant designed to enhance the performance of herbicides, fungicides and insecticides through more uniform coverage and retention of sprays. **Horizon** coats the plant leaf with a thin film that penetrates the leaf for faster pesticide absorption. This intimate interaction with the plant leaf along with a special blend of sticking agents, can decrease the chance of washoff by overhead irrigation and rain.

FIRST AID

If in eyes: Hold eyes open and flush with plenty of clean water for at least 15 minutes. See a physician.

If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area with soap and water. See a physician if irritation persists.

If swallowed: Give victim large quantities of water; do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if needed. See a physician.

If contact is made with the spray solution containing pesticides, follow the "Statement of Practical Treatment" on the pesticide label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE Shake Well Before Using

Use Rates:

Defoliants and Desiccants	4-8 pints per 100 gallons
Fungicides and Miticides	1-4 pints per 100 gallons
Herbicides	4-8 pints per 100 gallons
Insecticides	4-8 pints per 100 gallons
Wettable Powders	1-4 pints per 100 gallons

Aerial: Use 4 ounces of **Horizon** per acre.

Mixing Instructions: Prior to any pesticide application, the spray tank and all mixing equipment must be thoroughly cleaned. Always read the pesticide(s) label carefully before use. Add **Horizon** to the spray tank with good agitation, after all other spray materials have been added.

These directions for use do not constitute a recommendation to use any toxicant in any manner contrary to the directions of the manufacturer.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in original container in a dry location. Keep container closed in storage.
