## March Tips

- March is a great time to prune most woody landscape plants and fruit trees.
- Keep feeding the birds until spring bloom since they have come to depend upon you for food.
- Providing a fresh source of water will help attract more birds to your yard. Be sure to keep the water free of ice.
- Don't worry if spring-flowering bulbs are sending up green leaves. The foliage can withstand winter weather.
- March is the leanest month for wildlife, so protect shrubs and plants with wire cages or sprinkle ground with cat hair, blood meal, or other deterrent.
- Rake off last season's mulches on garden soil so it can dry and be warmed by the sun. Remove any plant residue left from last year.
- If the compost pile froze during winter, turn it now, and add fresh manure to help restart the composting process.
- Sharpen lawn mower blades and have mower serviced before spring rush.
