

# April Tips

- Stop Crabgrass before it starts with a well-timed crabgrass preventer application. When forsythia are about to bloom, make your application.
- Take a soil test so you'll know which nutrients and/or lime that your lawn or garden needs. Think of a soil test as a pin in a map to show you where you are. You can't get to where you want to be if you don't know where you are now.
- Aerate your lawn to allow water, air and nutrition to get down to the roots. Aeration will also help prevent soil compaction and break up thatch.
- Clean and disinfect bird feeders and houses to prevent parasites and diseases.
- Root crops and leafy greens can be planted this month
